FLAGSTAFF HILL MARITIME VILLAGE

Flagstaff Hill Maritime Village is set on 10 acres and takes you back in time to the pioneering days of shipwrecks and whaling in the 1870s. Its Sound and Laser Show tells the story of the "Loch Ard" and the miraculous survival of the world famous 'larger-than-life' peacock and only two passengers, Eva Carmichael and Tom Pearce.
